Prototype High School

This award winning 330,000 square foot high school design organizes ten brick banded buildings around a central campus plaza. The school design serves grades nine through twelve with core facilities for 2,500 students to be built on various sites, each having a minimum of sixty acres. The design solution addresses a need for student and community educational, cultural and recreational opportunities.

The ultimate solution resulted in a campus design which adapts to various sites, allows for strong visual orientation and control of students, and is organized to create a strong sense of place on campus. This is the exemplification of the community school concept. It elicits an image which stands proudly in the community mind.

Science/Engineering Building

Peacock + Lewis provided planning, design and construction administration for this complete research facility in a multi-story solution of approximately 135,000 square feet. This state of the art science and engineering facility includes faculty and research offices as well as full service laboratory facilities for a complete curriculum including biology, physics, chemistry, geology, astronomy, laser technology, robotics, and computer science.

Performing Arts Auditorium,

Peacock + Lewis provided planning, design and construction administration services for two prototypical performing arts auditoriums to be utilized on numerous high school campuses throughout Palm Beach County. In both the 834 and the 654 seat designs, students and the community have an opportunity to participate in and experience the visual and performing arts. With an engineered acoustical envelope, orchestra pit, fully rigged stage house, catwalk network and specialized sound, video and lighting equipment, these buildings are well equipped to support professional productions. Also included are complete dressing room areas, prop construction/workshop areas, exterior staging area for props and stage sets. Separate climate controls have been designed for costume storage, piano storage and the auditorium seating area to provide economy of operation.



Suncoast Community High School

Palm Beach Community College

Peacock + Lewis provided the master planning and implementation of phased construction for this community college campus of 6,000 students. The master plan utilizes a fractured traditional grid pattern for the campus, enabling plaza areas to be created between groups of structures. The existing lush subtropical vegetation, combined with a free-form roadway system, softens the formal grid pattern. This main roadway encircles the entire campus with pockets of strategically placed parking, thus allowing an organic growth with automobiles never intersecting pedestrian thoroughfares.

Prototypical Elementary Schools

Peacock + Lewis provided planning, design and construction administration for three elementary schools utilizing one prototype design. The design is based upon a student population of 750 with the flexibility to grow with the community need to a population of 1,000 students. A satellite pod orientation with a central core community was developed to allow for the segregation of primary and intermediate grade levels.

Lake Worth High School

Peacock + Lewis provided master planning, renovations and additions to Lake Worth High School for the School Board of Palm Beach County. This project entailed detailed campus evaluations of existing structures which resulted in a program of phased demolition, renovations and new construction. The established program was to renovate existing buildings consolidating educational programs throughout the campus and create a cohesive campus image. The design solution created a strong school identity, facilitated community use and preserved buildings of historical significance.

The campus is a medical, a law enforcement, and an R.O.T.C. magnet school.
